

1. Introduction

The Boom SIM range has been designed specifically to work with Boom's hosted voice platform. All the SIMs can act as extensions, be part of hunt-groups and be called by extension number from any other extension on a customer's hosted partition. In addition, all calls and texts can be recorded and within the analytics, the SIMs act just like any other extension. This is true Unified Communications (UC).


There are two sub-ranges, one which can operate on multiple UK networks, failing over if the current network has no coverage and a second sub-range which is a little cheaper and just operates on a single network.



2. Multi-network SIMS

These SIMs start on the O2 network as 3G and if there is no O2 coverage, they fail-over to Vodafone and EE, where they will support 4G. They support international roaming.

There are two multi-network SIMs, dependent on the data requirement and bundled 01/02/03 and 07 minutes and texts:



1. 1GB of data, 1,000 call minutes and 1,000 texts per month
2. 4GB of data, 1,500 call minutes and 1,500 texts per month

3. Single-network SIMS

The single-network 4G SIMs use the Three network and have three options:



1. 1GB of data, 1,000 call minutes and 1,000 texts per month
2. 3GB of data, unlimited call minutes and texts per month
3. 10GB of data, unlimited call minutes and texts per month

These SIMs do not have the ability to roam internationally.
